BY-LAW NUMBER 68-2010

BEING A BY-LAW TO ADOPT A SOLAR PANEL POLICY FOR THE TOWNSHIP
OF ASHFIELD-COLBORNE-WAWANOSH.

WHEREAS the Council of the Township of Ashfield-Colborne-Wawanosh deems it expedient to establish a Solar Panel Policy.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Ashfield-Colborne-Wawanosh enacts as follows:

1. The Corporation of the Township of Ashfield-Colborne-Wawanosh hereby adopts the Solar Panel Policy contained in the attached Schedule 'A' to this by-law.
2. The By-law shall come into full force and effect upon its final passage.
3. This By-law may be cited as the 'Solar Panel Policy By-law.'

POLICIES & PROCEDURES MANUAL

SECTION: Roads

POLICY: Solar Panels

COVERAGE: This policy will stipulate a policy in regards to damage to solar panels located in close proximity to Township Road Allowances and setting appropriate setbacks.

Policy Statement:

Solar Panels that are damaged by snow, stones, and any other debris coming off of Township equipment on Road Allowances will be the property owner's responsibility. The Township will not be liable for any damage occurred.

A Solar Panel shall meet a setback of 17 metres from the road allowance.
