



## **PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE**

**Date: April 9, 2018**

**To: Huron Sands Drinking Water Users**

**Please note: This notice is not the result of detected bacteria in the water,  
but is only a precautionary measure.**

**The system has just been turned on for the season.  
The Precautionary Boil Water Notice will be lifted once the samples taken have  
been cleared by the Health Unit.**

**Please take the following precautions:**

**BOIL** your water at a rolling boil for at least **ONE MINUTE** before using it for:

- drinking
- gargling, brushing your teeth or rinsing dentures
- washing fruits, vegetables or other food
- making ice, juices, puddings or other mixes
- making baby food or formula

You may also use bottled water instead of boiled water for the above-mentioned uses.

**Washing, bathing, showering, laundry, dishwashing can be carried out as usual.**

**This precautionary Boil Water Notice will be in effect until the water has been sampled and tested as free from bacteria.**

**You will be notified when the Boil Water Notice is lifted.**
